

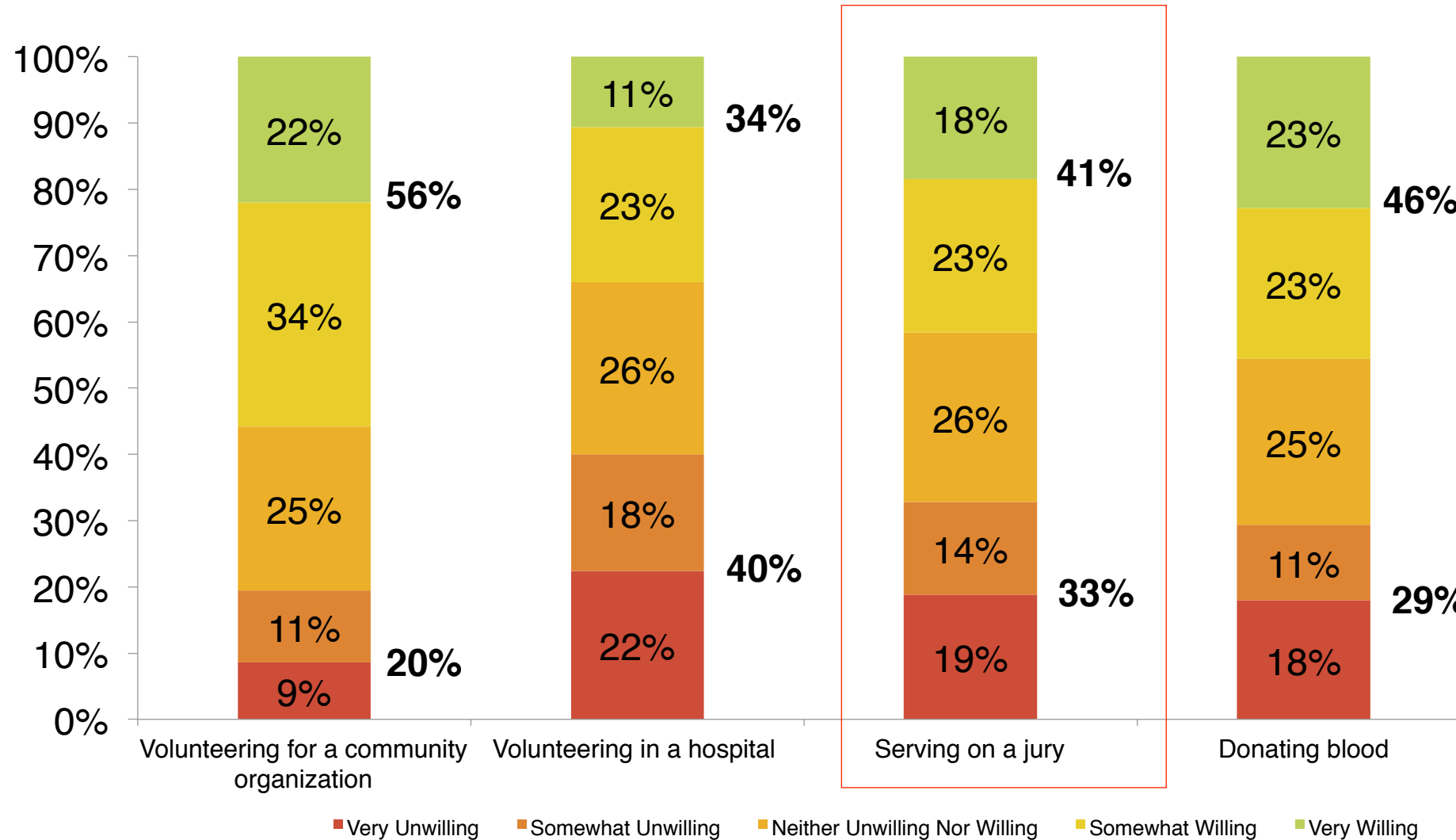
# COVID-19 AND JURY DUTY NATIONAL OMNIBUS OPINION SURVEY

# TOPLINE FINDINGS

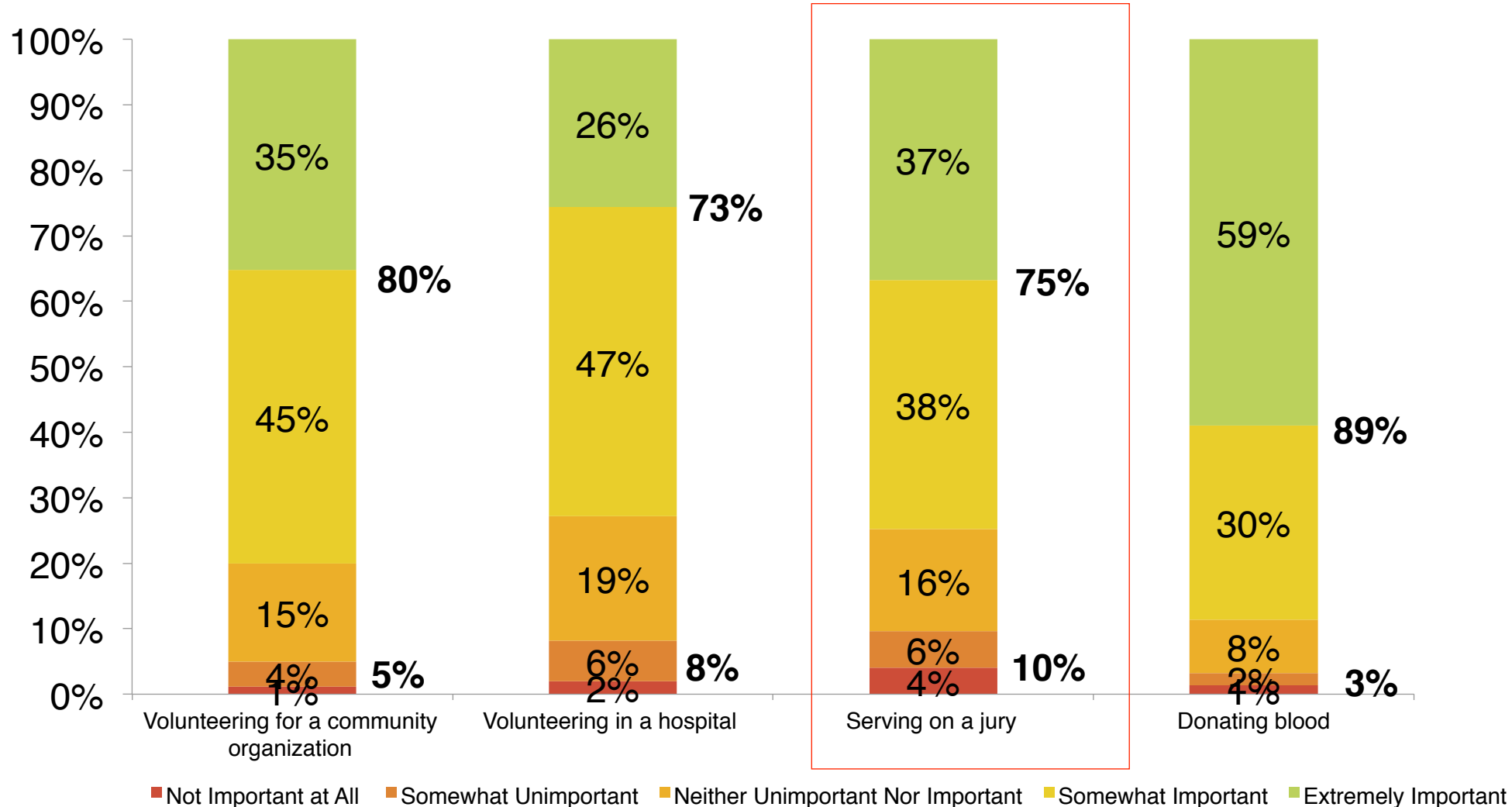
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- **Canadians willingness to Serve on a Jury post-COVID-19 is low, behind only Volunteering at a Hospital**
- **More Canadians were willing to Donate Blood, or Volunteer for a Community Organization than Serve on a Jury**
- **Canadians see Jury Duty as less important to society than Donating Blood, and Volunteering for a Community Organization**
- **Half of Canadians are unwilling to sit in Close Proximity on a Jury, second only to Riding in a Crowded Elevator post-COVID-19**
- **In the past-two-weeks amid COVID-19, more than six-in-ten Canadians said they were Worried about Being in Public Places**

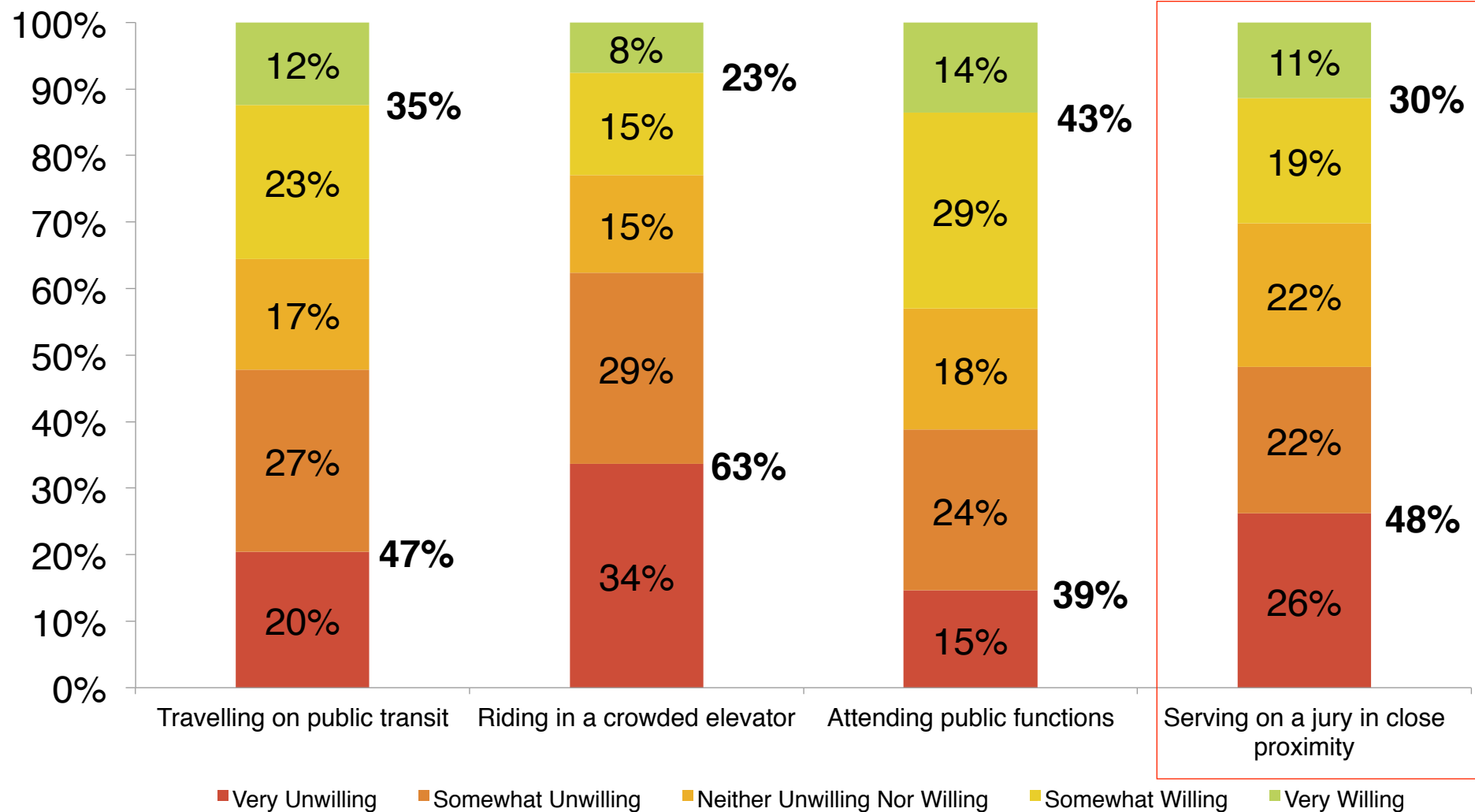


# Canadians see Jury Duty as less important to society than Donating Blood, and Volunteering for a Community Organization

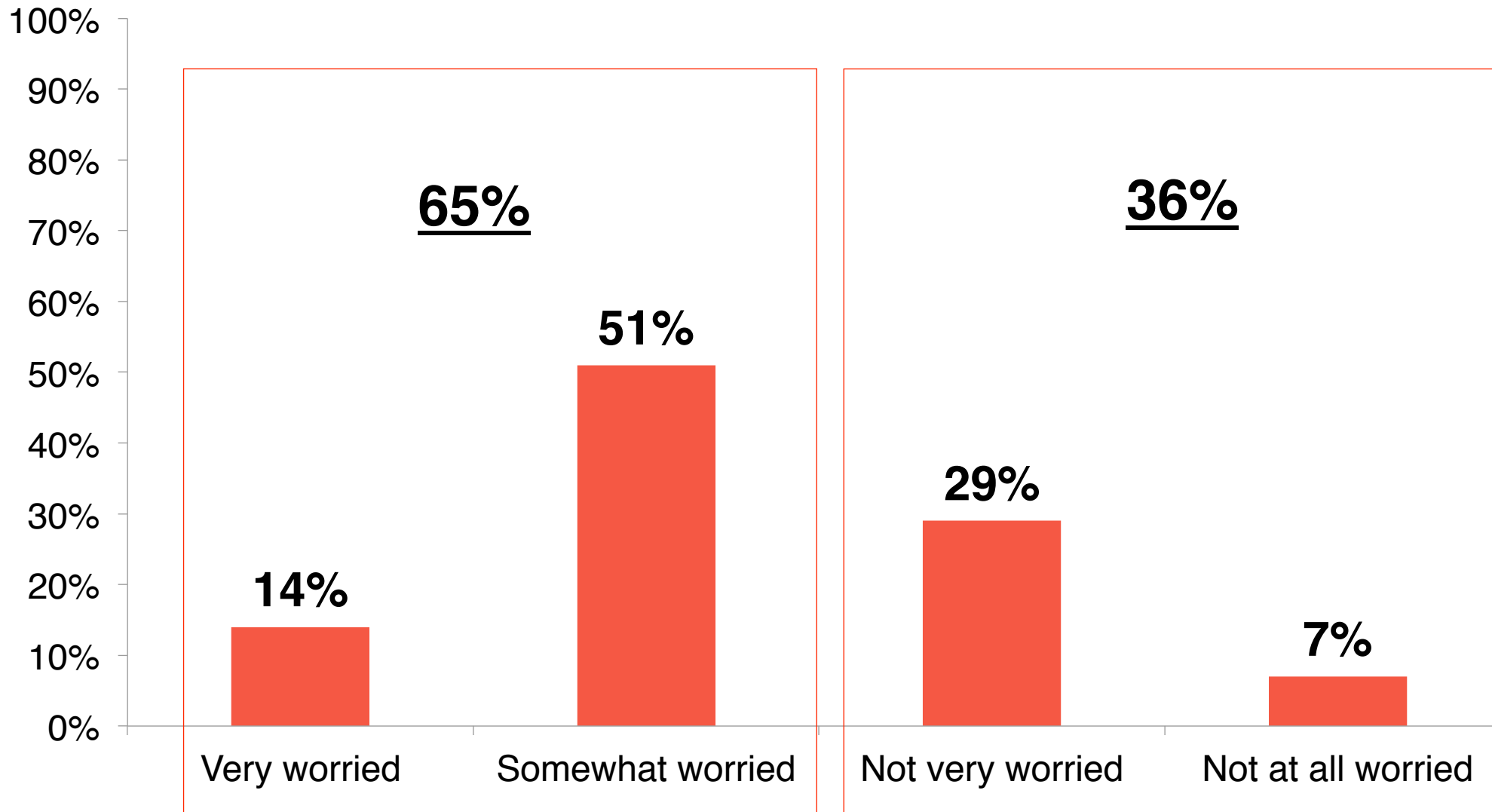


On a scale of 1- 5, with 1 being Not Important at All and 5 being Extremely Important, please describe how important you think each of the following activities are as part of Canadian society?
